COURSE OVERVIEW

Each apprentice will develop the skills required to support the care and education of babies and young children, managing a group of key children, undertaking assessments and planning for their individual needs. Apprentices will develop the skills and behaviours to work directly with babies and young children aged 0-8 years in a variety of settings. Each learner will be responsible for planning and preparing teaching and learning, whilst working in partnership to support children's development.

FAQs

Is this for new or existing staff members?

Both. This course works to upskill long standing employees, and for new people entering the sector for the first time.

What kind of time commitment is required?

The ESFA requires 20% of your contracted hours to be committed to off-the-job training. This could include learning that you already undertake at work, dedicated time with your Interserve Learning & Employment Trainer Assessor, independent learning activities, participation in first aid training and other activity. Ask your Trainer Assessor for more details.

Am I eligible for this course?

The main requirements are that you work 50% or more in England, and that this qualification would represent 'significant new skills' (i.e. generally that you have not completed this course before). There are other detailed requirements that we will go through with you during the initial assessment and enrolment process.

How will the course be assessed?

You will be required to undertake a number of workplace observations carrying out your day to day duties, take part in professional discussions and provide reflective accounts of your practice. Your employer can also support the assessment process by providing witness testimonies as evidence of your competency.

Where will my sessions take place?

All face-to-face sessions will be conducted in your place of work at a date and time to suit yourself and your employer. These are monthly visits you will be required to attend.


